PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

EMT's are educated to provide medical care to people who have suffered from an illness or an injury outside of the hospital setting. EMT's work under protocols approved by a physician medical director to recognize, assess, and manage emergencies and transport patients to definitive medical care. EMTs provide basic life support.

The Emergency Medical Technician's course educates participants to be a part of the nation's Emergency Medical System. Emphasis includes scene control, patient assessment, triage, use of standard equipment, transport concerns, legalities, and physiological theory related to medical and trauma situations. The EMT course requirements include full course attendance, online assignments, ambulance patient contacts, skill test competencies and passing on the cognitive pre-exam final. EMT National Certification requires successful completion of NREMT practical exam and successful completion of the NREMT computer adaptive exam held off-site.

PROGRAM NOTES

- The EMT Education Program is approved by the Minnesota State EMSRB and the NREMT.
- There is a required background check for both regulatory agencies.
