		Complete Master Promissory Note (MPN) and Entrance Counseling at <a href="www.studentaid.gov">www.studentaid.gov</a> using the same username and password used to complete the FAFSA.
		Keep your username and password in a safe, accessible place. You will need it in the future.
4.	Re	egistration for New Students
		Once you have completed the enrollment requirements, you will be invited to begin our registration process. We conduct phone or virtual appointments if you are not able to make it to campus. During this appointment, you'll meet with an academic advisor and discuss your academic goals, course placement (GPA and/or prior college credits), and get registered for fall classes.
		Be sure to register for the mandatory zero credit Varsity Football course. (You have a choice to also take Competitive Football for credit.)
