## Emergency Medical Technician – EMSV 1500 (8 credits / 156 hours)

**Tuition & Fees:** \$1,705.59 (approx.) and NREMT Exam fee (\$95) PSEO Eligible

**Books:** \$386.00 (approx.) The book we are using is AAOS Emergency Care and Transportation for the Sick and Injured, 12<sup>th</sup> ed., manual and workbook set with mandatory online codes. (no used books, please) Books are available at the Eveleth campus bookstore, you must order them online.
