



10TH GRADE PSEO ELIGIBLE COURSES

2026-27

Legislation allows eligible 10th-grade students to enroll in one Career and Technical Education (CTE) course through PSEO. If the student earns a grade of “C” or higher in that first course, they become eligible to take additional postsecondary courses during 10th grade, including CTE, MnTC, general education, or college success strategy courses.

A 10th-grade student is eligible only if they achieved a “meets” or “exceeds” proficiency level on the 8th-grade MCA reading test. If the student did not take the MCA, an alternative reading assessment accepted by the enrolling postsecondary institution may be used instead.

High school students participating in the Postsecondary Enrollment Options (PSEO) program at another Minnesota State college or university must complete Minnesota North College’s PSEO application and admissions process. Students who register for classes without completing this process will be responsible for any unpaid balances associated with their registrations.
