PLEASE READ CAREFULLY BEFORE SIGNING THIS FORM

As a condition to my admission, I agree to the following:

- I understand that this application and supporting documents become the property of Minnesota North College regardless of the admission decision. As such, once the documents are received by Minnesota North, the documents will not be returned to the applicant/student.
- I understand that I am required to pay ALL tuition and fees (which includes mandatory purchase of health insurance) by the designated payment deadline date EACH semester. If I do not pay by the deadline date, I understand I will be prohibited from registering for future semesters. By failing to register, my nonimmigrant status as an F-1 student will be terminated and I will be required to leave the country within 15 days.
- I will have available sufficient funds for tuition, fees, health Insurance and living expenses for each year I study at Minnesota North College. I recognize that the cost of living is high, that financial aid from the College is not available, and that as a general rule, International students are not permitted to work off campus.
- I am solely responsible for understanding the rules and regulations for being on a student visa in the United States. Minnesota North College is not responsible for maintaining my nonimmigrant status.
- I authorize Minnesota North College to release to any U.S. Government Officer information required to determine my compliance with non-immigrant visa requirements and laws. Furthermore, I understand that Minnesota North will report to U.S. Homeland Security students who are not registered, are not pursuing a full course load (12 credits) each semester, or are not meeting the minimum academic standards of the College.
- I agree to purchase the Minnesota State system International Student Health Insurance Plan and pay in full for the year prior to the start of the semester as a condition of admission and continued enrollment (Estimated cost of \$2956/year). I understand the only exception to this requirement is if my sponsoring government or agency certifies in writing that coverage is in effect under a plan provided by my sponsoring government or agency, per [Minnesota State Board Policy 3.4.1 Part 11, Subpart B](#)
- I agree to attend all required sessions of New Student Orientation on my campus. I will arrive on or before the program start date as stated on the I-20 form.
- I declare that all the information I have submitted for my application for admission is true, correct and complete.
- I understand and will comply with the requirements as stated on this agreement. I understand that falsification of any information will jeopardize the issuance of an I-20 and/or may result in Minnesota North College revoking my acceptance.

Estimated Expenses

F-1 International Students | 2026-2027 Academic Year

The below expenses are estimates only and subject to change. We have divided expenses into two groups: what you will pay the college directly and additional personal expenses you will likely incur traveling to and attending college. As an international applicant, you are required to demonstrate that you and/or your sponsor have adequate financial resources to pay for all of the following expenses.

What You Will Pay Minnesota North College

Estimated yearly college-related expenses

Tuition & Fees	\$6,648	Total for 30 credits per year at the in-person tuition rate of \$209.70 per credit- the same rate Minnesota residents pay. You will pay more or less depending on the number of credits you take per semester. Most students must take an average of 15 credits per semester (30 per year) to complete a program in two years.
Books & Supplies	\$660	This number varies widely by academic program. You may choose to purchase or rent books from Minnesota North College or any other seller.
Housing & Meals	\$7,000	Housing and meal costs vary by campus, room type and meal service options. This figure is an average across all campuses. International students are not required to live on campus.
Health/Medical Insurance*	\$2,956	Most international students are required to purchase the Minnesota State system Health/Medical Insurance through UnitedHealthcare. *The only exception is the only exception to this requirement is if your sponsoring government or agency certifies in writing that coverage is in effect under a plan provided by your sponsoring government or agency, per Minnesota State system Board Policy 3.4.1 part 3, subpart B.2.
TOTAL	\$17,264	This is the estimated total you will owe the college per year. The Health/Medical Insurance must be paid in full prior to the start of classes; all other charges may be paid in installments each semester by enrolling in the college's payment plan.

Personal Expenses	\$1,500	Transportation, clothing, etc. – Will vary widely depending on student's individual situation.
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*USCIS requires that we include estimates of personal expenses and transportation costs in the total amount students must show proof of funding for. These are not costs you will owe the college.
