Complete these To-Do items before you arrive:

1. Apply to Minnesota North College – Vermilion Campus

- Complete online application at www.minnesotanorth.edu and pay the \$20 application fee.
- On the application, you will see Minnesota North College, we are the Vermilion Campus.
- Provide your [immunization record](#) (vaccine/shot records) **before** you arrive to campus.
- Request your FINAL, OFFICIAL high school transcript to be sent to Minnesota North College.
- Request OFFICIAL college transcripts, if applicable to you, be sent to Minnesota North College.

We cannot accept unofficial transcripts, so have above requested transcripts sent directly to:

2. Submit On-Campus Housing Contract – Must pay deposit within 5 days of filling out the housing application to have it processed and a room assigned. (Preference goes to those completed by June 15th.)

- Fill out the 2026-2027 Vermilion Campus housing contract and pay the \$250 deposit within 5 days. This contract is in your [student e-services account](#) under Housing and Dining. Pay deposit in your account under Bills and Payments. Cancellations after June 1st will result in loss of the \$250 deposit.

3. Reserve ON-Campus housing and meal plan for the two weeks of volleyball camp by indicating volleyball on your housing application.

- Early arrival housing fee of \$100 will be placed on Fall charges. Move-in on Monday, August 10th or Tuesday, August 11th between 10am-4pm. Check-in before 4pm on either day.

4. Camp Meals

- The fee for volleyball camp meals is \$180. These fees will also be placed on Fall charges. Scrimmage travel days will have a boxed lunch provided to take with you.

5. Complete Financial Aid Application – Start now and COMPLETE all steps before arriving to camp!

You will not play in your first game until you meet your financial obligation for the fall (FAFSA completed with aid awards accepted, completed MPN & Entrance Counseling on file, and/or payment in full or payment plan in place).

- Complete your FAFSA at www.studentaid.gov using school code: **002355 (Minnesota North College) – it will say a Hibbing MN address.**
- Complete Master Promissory Note (MPN) and Entrance Counseling at www.studentaid.gov using the same username and password used to complete the FAFSA.
- Keep your username and password safe and accessible. You will need it in the future while on campus.
- Review and accept aid offerings your [student e-services account](#). It takes 3-5 business days for financial aid staff to see your FAFSA information before they can process and make your student aid offerings.

6. Registration for New Students

- Once you have completed your admissions steps & enrollment requirements, schedule a phone, virtual or in-person appointment with an academic advisor who will discuss your academic goals and course placement (high school/college GPAs and/or prior college credits) to enroll you in fall classes.
- Be sure to register for the mandatory zero credit Varsity Volleyball course. (You have a choice to also take Competitive Volleyball for 1 credit.) Your advisor can explain both course options.

7. Schedule your annual health physical using Vermilion's NJCAA approved Examination form.

- Schedule and complete a physical exam with your local clinic. Physician must complete and sign the examination form. The [Physical Examination Form](#) is available on the college website.
- Mail the medical form to Minnesota North College, "Attention Athletic Director Bender" 1900 E Camp St, Ely MN 55731 or email completed form to admissions@minnesotanorth.edu.

8. Secure Health Insurance - MANDATORY to play volleyball

- Mail a copy of your insurance card to Minnesota North College, "Attention Athletic Director Bender" 1900 E Camp St, Ely MN 55731 or mail to admissions@minneostanorth.edu
- Bring your insurance card with you to camp.

9. Order Player Pack. Check with Coach Redman Wiggen and Athletic Director Aaron Bender for more information. Personal property fees will be charged to Fall semester.

10. Make Travel arrangements to Minnesota North College, Vermilion Campus (1900 E Camp St, Ely, MN) to arrive by August 11th. For students arriving by bus or plane, [please see last page](#).

Financial Aid and Paying for College

Paying for college can feel overwhelming. We are here to help make the process as smooth as possible. Please keep these things in mind as you make plans to pay for your college experience.

- Minnesota North College does NOT offer athletic scholarships (NJCAA DIII is Non-Scholarship).
- Financial Aid eligibility is determined after you file your FAFSA (Complete your FAFSA early).
- Be prepared to use savings, private or Parent Plus loans or other resources to help pay your balance due.
- Check your [eServices account](#) to:
 - Access your **Financial Aid Offer notification** to determine what aid you are eligible for and accept aid.
 - Confirm your balance prior to setting up a payment plan or making a payment. You can set up a payment plan with estimated costs before final tuition rates are set by Minnesota State.
